

# STRUCTURE

## ANGLICAN CHURCH IN NORTH AMERICA

### ASSEMBLY



250-300 Members



Representation proportional to diocesan size with additional youth delegates



Ratifies changes to the Constitution and Canons



Meets at least every 5 years

### EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE



12 elected members (half clergy & half laity)



Prepares budget and oversees the administration of the church in between Provincial Council meetings



Meets monthly by conference call, and triannually in person (FEB, JUN, and AUG)

### PROVINCIAL COUNCIL



120-140 Members



4 representatives per diocese (half clergy & half laity)



Approves the budget, elects members to the Executive Committee, recommends to the Assembly changes to the Constitution and Canons

### COLLEGE OF BISHOPS



50 members



Oversees and guards the worship and doctrine of the church



Meets biannually (JAN and JUN)



A church elects members to the Diocesan Council (half clergy & half laity)



Each Diocesan Council elects members to Provincial Council and Assembly



The Diocesan Councils & College of Bishops elect new bishops into the College of Bishops



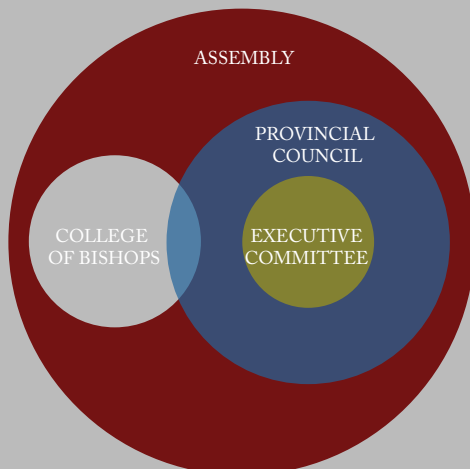
Provincial Council is made up of four elected members from each Diocesan Council



Assembly is made up of members from each Diocesan Council, proportionate to diocesan size



Executive Committee is elected by Provincial Council



College of Bishops - all members are part of Assembly, diocesans are members of Provincial Council & may be elected to Executive Committee

Executive Committee - members are part of Assembly and Provincial Council

Provincial Council - most members are part of Assembly
