

CONFIDENTIALITY STATEMENT OF THE COURT

Trial Court of a Bishop – Anglican Church in North America

The Trial Court of a Bishop operates under a strict Confidentiality Order governing all aspects of its proceedings. This Order is binding upon all Court members, the Respondent and his counsel, the Provincial Prosecutor—whether current or former—and any individual personally assisting the prosecution or the Court with respect to the present matter pending before this Court.

This confidentiality mandate exists to preserve the integrity of the Court’s proceedings and to guard against the dissemination of partial or misleading information that may arise when matters under adjudication are discussed outside the bounds of the processes established by our Constitution and Canons.

The President of this Court, the Right Reverend David Bryan, respectfully requests your full understanding and faithful observance of this confidentiality obligation. Only by maintaining this discipline can the Church ensure the fairness, credibility, and spiritual integrity of its judicial processes.
